The State Government may, by notification, specify the limits of the area in which the university shall exercise its powers. As per Punjabi University, Patiala, Calendar 2014, Punjab Government vide notification no. 8277-2(28)-EDI-ASO(II)72 dated 18-09-1972 had extended the jurisdiction of the University to the districts of Patiala, Sangrur, Bathinda, Ropar and Faridkot. Over the years, some new districts were carved out of the existing districts. Following are the details:

- On 9th April 1992, Fatehgarh Sahib was made a separate district from the existing District of Patiala.
- On 13th April 1992, Mansa was made a separate district from the existing District of Bathinda.
- On 14th April 2006, Mohali was made a separate district from the existing District of Ropar.
- On 8th November 2006, Barnala was made a separate district from the existing District of Sangrur.
- On 2nd June 2021, Malerkotla was made a separate district from the existing District of Sangrur.

At present, 10 districts fall in the territorial jurisdiction of Punjabi University, Patiala as per different notifications issued by Government of Punjab at different points of time.

- (14) to make special provision for the spread of University education among classes and communities which are educationally backward;
- (15) to make provision for:
- the maintenance of National Cadet Corps or other similar training corps,
 - physical and military training,
 - students associations, and
 - sports and athletic clubs;
- (16) to prepare, translate and publish, and to assist other bodies and individuals in the preparation, translation and publication of books, journals, periodicals and any other material in Punjabi or other languages;
- (17) to create administrative, ministerial and other necessary posts and to make appointments thereto;
- (18) to receive gifts, donations or benefactions from Government and to receive bequests, donations and transfers of moveable or immoveable property from testators donors or transferors, as the case may be;
- (19) to frame Statutes, Ordinances or Regulations for all or any of the aforesaid purposes; and to alter, modify or rescind the same and;
- (20) to do all such other acts and things, whether incidental to the powers aforesaid or not, as may be requisite in order to further the objects of the University.

CHAPTER-VI ADMISSION OF COLLEGES

1. *Admission of Colleges to the Privileges of the University*
The University shall establish and maintain such colleges, institutions and halls as may be decided upon by the Syndicate, from time to time, after considering the recommendations of the Academic Council.

The organization, conditions of maintenance and management of such colleges, institutions and halls shall be prescribed by the Ordinances.

Colleges shall be of two types, namely, University Colleges and Affiliated Colleges.

No. 2/3/92-REH(I)/4412.—In exercise of the powers conferred by section 5 of the Punjab Land Revenue Act, 1887 (Act 17 of 1887) and all other powers enabling him in this behalf, the Governor of Punjab is pleased to direct that with effect from the 13th day of April, 1992 :—

- (1) the Fatehgarh Sahib Tehsil of the existing district of Patiala, excluding 14 revenue estates specified in schedule 'A' shall form part of a separate district to be known as the Fatehgarh Sahib District, with headquarters at Fatehgarh Sahib.
- (2) the Fatehgarh Sahib district so formed shall also include the other revenue estates of the existing district of Patiala specified in schedule 'B' the revenue estates of the existing district of Ropar specified in schedule 'C' and the revenue estates of the existing district of Ludhiana specified in schedule 'D'.
- (3) the Fatehgarh Sahib Tehsil so forming a part of the separate district of Fatehgarh Sahib referred to in para 1 above and the other revenue estates of the existing districts of Patiala, Ropar and Ludhiana specified in the schedules referred to in para 2 above shall cease to form part of the existing districts of Patiala, Ropar and Ludhiana from which they have been excluded.
- (4) the Fatehgarh Sahib district so formed shall be included in the Patiala Division.

Because of its connectivity with the union territory of Chandigarh, the district has been formed to achieve growth of development as this area is emerging as major I.T.hub of Northern India. The district includes Mohali, Kharar and Dera Bassi Tehsils. It is located in the north east part of Punjab. and is part of Rupnagar division. The District includes 383 villages. The important township in the district are Kharar, Kurali, Mohali, Zirakpur & Dera Bassi. Kharar block is the largest administrative unit of the district with 138 villages followed by Majri block with 116 villages and Derabassi block with 102 villages. 27 villages were newly added in the District Sahibzada Ajit Singh Nagar which were carved out from District Patiala.

1. the Barnala Tehsil consisting of 12-Kanungo Circles, 116 Patwar Circles and 130 Revenue Villages (Revenue Estates) as per Annexures—'A', 'B', 'C' and 'D' of existing District of Sangrur shall stand upgraded as a separate district to be known as the Barnala District, with headquarters at Barnala ;

3. the existing Sub-Tehsil Badhau consisting of 2-Kanungo Circles, 20-Patwar Circles and 24 Revenue Villages as per Annexure 'D' shall be a part of Barnala Sub-Division/Tehsil ;
4. the 2-Sub-Divisions/Tehsils, namely, Barnala and Tapa shall be two Tehsils/Sub-Divisions of the newly formed District of Barnala.
5. the Barnala District so formed shall be included in the Patiala Division.

No. 02/03/2016H.M-2(1)/7767 -In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 5 of the Punjab Land Revenue Act, 1887 (Act No. XVII of 1887) and all other powers enabling him in this behalf, the Governor of Punjab is pleased to direct that with immediate effect as under:-

1. The Sub-Divisions of Malerkotla and Ahmedgarh of district Sangrur will form part of a separate District to be known as Malerkotla District with headquarters at Malerkotla.
2. The Sub-division of Malerkotla has been re-organised by upgrading Sub-Tehsil of Amargarh into a Sub-Division, which earlier formed a part of Malerkotla Sub-Division.
3. The District of Malerkotla will have three Sub-Divisions namely, Malerkotla, Amargarh and Ahemedgarh. It will consist of a total of 192 villages with 6 Kanungo circles. The Malerkotla Sub-Division/Tehsil will have 90 villages, Amargarh Sub-Division/Tehsil will have 49 villages and Ahmedgarh Sub-Division/Tehsil will have 53 Villages. The detail of Villages falling in the district and the sub-divisions of the district is at Annexure-A.
4. The Malerkotla District so formed shall be included in Patiala Division.
